What to expect and plan for:

- Though class technically begins at 5:00pm, on the Friday of the first day of class you ***MUST show up early at 4:30pm*** in the **student commons** on the **first floor** to:
 - Get your book for the class.
 - Get your access swipe card.
 - Get your identification badge.
 - Meet your instructor.
 - Meet your fellow classmates.
 - From there your instructor will guide students from the student commons to the classroom and begin class promptly at 5:00pm.
- **If you arrive later than 5:00pm on the first day of class you will not be admitted into the class, and you will not receive a refund for the price of the class.**
- Class will run until 9:00pm on Friday.
- Class will begin promptly at 10:00am and run until 6:00pm on Saturday and Sunday.
- Your certification online exam attempt will be administered late-afternoon on Sunday. Before you will be allowed to take the exam you must:
 - Turn in your access swipe card to the instructor.
 - Turn in your identification badge to the instructor.
- 110 User Certification, 210M Operator Music Certification, and 210P Operator Post Certification, 310M Expert Post Certification, and 310P Expert Post Certification all have an online exam that must be passed in order to attain certification. Your first two attempts at the exam are free. The third and each subsequent exam costs \$35, which is paid directly to Avid via credit card at the time of the exam attempt.
- In addition to the online exam, the 310M Expert Music Certification and 310P Expert Post Certification also consist of an extensive hands-on component. This hands-on component will not be administered the weekend of the class. You will be required to study and practice the techniques you have learned for a minimum duration of one week before coming back to IPR and attempting this hands-on testing component.
